The first trial of the case of a Gulf War veteran exposed to Saddam's chemical weapons is now scheduled for three months from now, on June 17, 2013. It is expected to be a two-week trial. You are welcome to attend any or all of it if you have the opportunity to. This first trial will be of Major Victor Alarcon, M.D., who was the Field Surgeon for the 1st Armored Division, and who was medically retired after the war due to his mustard gas exposure in Iraq.


Dr. Alarcon's case and the remaining viable cases are mustard gas cases (rather than the broader nerve gas cases) as the mustard gas defendants are the only kind of defendant that we could get jurisdiction over in the U.S., as discussed in detail in the previous status report letters shown in this website.
